



# **ON TARGET**

When I was preaching at Robert Road Baptist Church recently I shared that 90% of the people in our county have said that they do not attend any evangelical church of any affiliation. One of the young men in that church was absolutely flabbergasted when I shared that.

He wondered how that could be true with all of the churches in the Tri-City area. (By the way, 90% of the people comes to about 180,000 people who are unchurched.)

How can this be? It does seem incredible, doesn't it? One of the reasons for this is that evangelical churches (Bible teaching, Christ honoring churches that believe faith in Christ is the only way to salvation) have forgotten what their mission is. We've forgotten that Jesus said his mission is to seek and to save the lost and then commissioned us to the same ministry to seeking out and sharing the gospel with the lost. Somehow we have become comfortable in our own salvation and have forgotten that others are truly lost without Christ.

We are going to have two opportunities for the churches in the YBA to come together to pray about local missions in the month of August. They are:

Sunday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, 6:00 PM at Robert Road Baptist Church, Prescott Valley.

Wednesday, August 15<sup>th</sup>, 6:00 PM at Clarkdale Baptist Church, Clarkdale.

Biblically, the pattern for the people of God in the Old and New Testaments was that when they needed God's help they gathered together to seek him. Southern Baptists have a long history of praying for missions. Let's continue the biblical pattern and the historical tradition by gathering together to pray for missions right here in our county.
