## **ON TARGET**



Hey:

A few weeks ago I was walking my wife's dog before I took off to whatever church I was preaching at that day. When we got to the little park across the street we noticed a house cat sitting at the top of a little tree. It was sitting on a couple of very thin branches (see the attached picture). Cooper (my wife's dog) almost laughed himself silly thinking about that cat up the tree. I, of course, felt sorry for it. But more than that I began wondering why did the cat go up the tree and how did it go up the tree. Since the cat wasn't talking, I was left up to my own imagination. My best guess is that a coyote was chasing the cat (that answers the "why" question); the cat went up the tree to save his life. "How" did the cat get up that skinny little branch? I think his motivation made the seemingly impossible possible.

When you look at the internal problems facing the American church today (which are too numerous and too obvious to those of us involved in the church to name), we have to ask ourselves, "How and why did we get where we are at?"

I hate to be simplistic, but I think the biggest cause of our problems is a lack of effective discipleship in the churches. We have not done a very good job of growing disciples and we are reaping the results today. Sadly, we have lost our evangelistic zeal. Leading people to Christ is the first step in effective discipleship. But when we do lead someone to faith in Christ, we have forgotten how important the care and feeding of spiritual babies is. No one with any sense at all would give birth to a child and leave it on its own to survive, but that is exactly what many of our churches have been doing for generations.



In a recent Pastors' Fellowship our pastors discussed the greatest needs our churches are facing. Guess what? The pastors identified discipleship as one of the greatest needs in the churches they serve. In response to that need the Church Strengthening Team has asked me to lead a discussion on effective discipleship at the April Pastors' Fellowship.

So on April 11<sup>th</sup>, 11:30 AM, at Robert Road Baptist Church, I will be leading a discussion on the subject of disciple-ship. I will have samples of discipleship materials that are available and even have some resources to give away. Pastors, please make this a high priority, we will be discussing the most effective, long term cure for the ailments of the church.


Pastor Keith Palmer
