By the time you read this it will be time for some of the kids to go back to school and others will be going back in the next week. Wow! Where did the summer go?

So how was your summer? What has been the highlight for you? Was it a vacation you and your family took? Maybe it was the Vacation Bible School at your church?

For me the highlight of my summer was our mission trip to Mescalero, NM. We took a team of 13 people to work on 4 projects.

- ◆ Many of you know about the construction project 6 of our guys took on. It was a doozie to say the least. Our guys worked hard for 5 days and ran into one new challenge after another, but they did a great job. Ultimately, they were able to partner with some of the men from First Baptist Church of Ruidoso to finish the project. The woman who owns the home has been living with her 3 children in one room of a family member's home. Soon she will be able to move into her own 3 bedroom home.
- ◆ The ladies on our team taught VBS to the Apache children. They did an afternoon Bible School to about 20 children each day. At the end of the week 3 preteen girls who tried to act uninterested all week professed their faith in Christ. The angels rejoiced!
- ◆ Our Roving Outreach Team prayer walked every residential neighborhood in the community twice then started knocking on doors to minister to and witness to the people. On Wednesday evening they encountered a group of people who needed the Lord and declared that they wanted to make a change in their lives. 3 of those people professed faith in Christ. The angels rejoiced! The team gave away free hotdogs one day and had the opportunity to witness to and pray for a number of people.
- ◆ My personal ministry (besides being involved in all of the above ministries) was to teach adults a discipleship study Monday – Thursday evenings. Between 6 and 10 Apache adults participated during the week. What a joy it was to open up the word of God to people who wanted to learn and grow in their faith.
- ◆ I have to say that the ladies also fed most of the adults and all of the children twice a day. They showed up at the church at 11:30 in the morning and didn't leave until after the adult discipleship study in the evening. The ladies fed about 50 people twice a day. That deserves a medal or something.

Thank you for the support that made this mission trip possible. You and your churches prayed and gave so that all of this ministry could be accomplished. Please be aware that your contribution made a difference in the lives of the Apache people in Mescalero, NM.

Let's keep working together to make a difference for the cause of Christ.
